[Charlotte Residence By Allison Ewing And William McDonough](#)



I have a weakness for green houses. And this is another one of those wood-filled lovely residences, warm and distinguished in a time where concrete and steel rule.

This private residence is located in Charlotte, North Carolina, in a 100 years old forest, to be more exact. The beautiful house was designed by Architects Allison Ewing and William McDonough from [William McDonough and Partners](#). 20 miles away from downtown Charlotte, this wooden wonder with rustic air was designed around the surrounding trees and built using OSB and lots of windows.



This house uses a geothermal system which makes it even more interesting because there are not many private residences using this system, even if itâ€™s highly â€œgreenâ€. Itâ€™s a single family two-story residence for those who care about the environment enough to make a house following the axes already made by the existing trees and not the opposite.
